

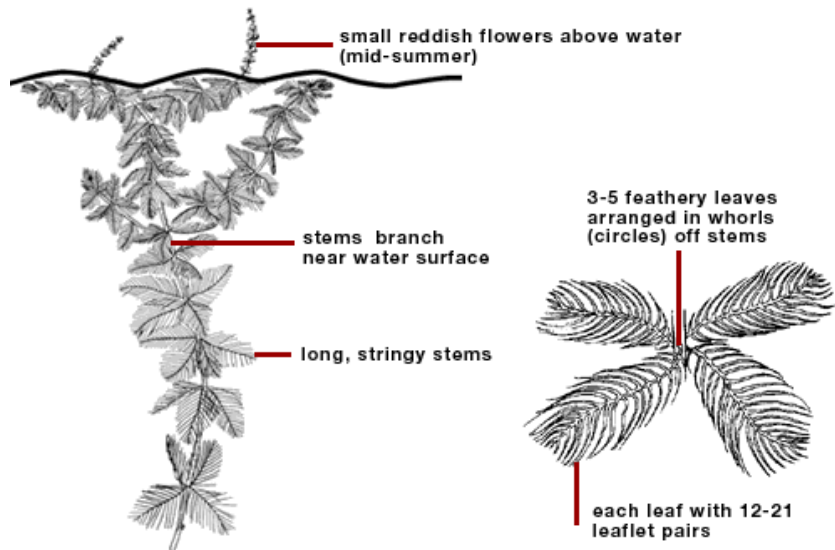

Hydrilla: Very aggressive! Forms dense mats of vegetation into deeper water than most aquatic vegetation that interfere with recreation and destroy fish and wildlife habitat.



Eurasian Milfoil: Typically has 12 to 21 pairs of leaflets on each of the 4 leaves in a whorl. Note opposed distribution of submerged leaflets. The native Northern Watermilfoil, with which it is often confused, usually has 5 to 9 pairs.

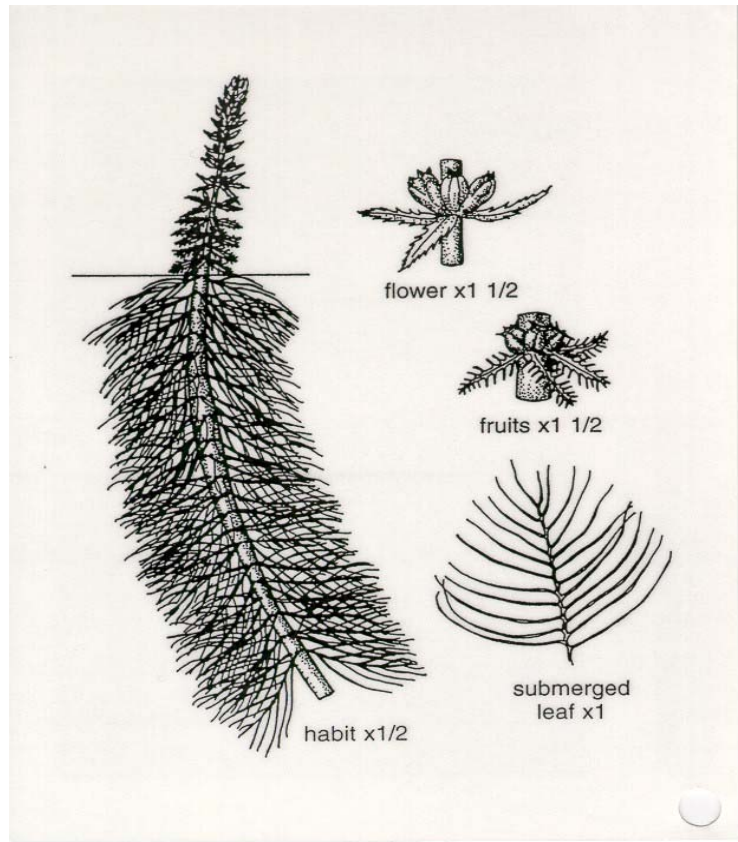


All motorized watercraft (including personal watercraft) operating on inland waters must display a Lake and River Protection Sticker. Funds are used for invasives management.
